# **Republic of Korea**

Republic of Korea (South Korea) is an East Asian nation on the southern half of the Korean Peninsula and East Asia's most developed country. #### Global Scholarship Program (GSP)

Global Scholarship Program (GSP) is a semester program that offers opportunities to experience professional, academic and cultural senses in Daejeon, Korea. GSP students are considered as exchange students and will be provided with benefits as below.

- 1. Tuition fee exemption
- 2. On-campus accommodation with meals
- 3. One time scholarship of 1,000,000 KRW / 500,000 KRW (depending on students' home nations)
- 4. Tuition discount by 50% for Intensive Korean Language Course. (The standard tuition fee for this course is 1,300,000 KRW.)
  \*Free Korean class is available for 10 weeks in the evenings on a first-come-first-served basis.

# Eligibility

- 1. Undergraduate or graduate students from partner universities
- 2. Either Korean or English language proficiency is required.
- 3. Official English test score is required for the students from non-English speaking countries: TOEIC 750, TOEFL iBT 60, or IELTS 5.5 on the academic module or Korean language proficiency in TOPIK level 3
- 4. Grade Average Point (GPA): Minimum 3.5 out of 4.5
- 5. Nomination from students' home universities
